



Five new Asian Turtle species are listed on CITES Appendix II

The following south-east Asian turtle species have been listed as Appendix II as a result of decisions made during the CITES CoP13 in Bangkok, October 2-14. The proposals were voted on Tuesday October 12, 2004.

- Malayan snail-eating turtle: *Malayemys subtrijuga* was listed in Appendix II (Prop.17).
- Malayan flat-shelled turtle: *Notochelys platynota* was listed in Appendix II (Prop.19)
- Southeast Asian soft-shell turtle: *Amyda cartilaginea* was listed in Appendix II (Prop.20).
- Roti snake-necked turtle: *Chelodina mccordi* was listed in Appendix II (Prop.23).
- Pig-nosed turtle: *Carettochelys insculpta* was listed in Appendix II (Prop. 22).
